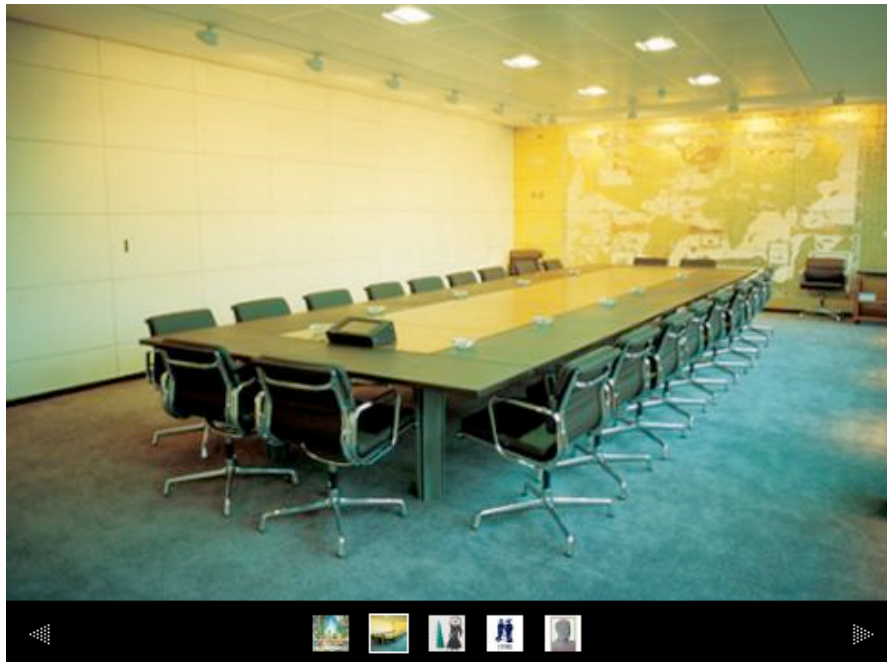

“Corporations Are People Too” at Winkleman Gallery

Taking its cue, perhaps, from the Supreme Court’s controversial *Citizens United v. Federal Election Commission* ruling of 2010—which struck down laws limiting campaign financing by finding that companies had the same First Amendment rights as individuals—this group show examines the treatment of corporations in both modern and contemporary art. Vintage photos by Berenice Abbott, Louis Faurer, Lewis Hine and Dorothea Lange are juxtaposed with recent works by Ian Davis, Chris Dorland, Kota Ezawa, Yevgeniy Fiks and Jacqueline Hassink to describe America’s love-hate relationship with big business.
